



# What is Relay?

Relay For Life is a community gathering where everyone can participate in the fight against cancer. Teams of people camp out at a local school, park, or fairgrounds and take turns walking or running around the track or path. Each team is asked to have a representative on the track at all times during the event - because cancer never sleeps. Relays are an overnight event, for everyone to enjoy.

Relay For Life brings together millions of people to raise money to help prevent cancer, save lives, and diminish suffering from the disease. While you're raising much needed funds, you'll also be raising awareness of cancer prevention, early detection, treatment, & patient support.
