

RELAY FOR LIFE RULES— FOR EVERYONE’S SAFETY...

We are guests of Westside High School and should exercise courtesy and care while using their wonderful facility. Team captains are responsible for their team members, families, and guests being made aware of and adhering to the following rules:

Each team captain or a designee should coordinate the campsite set-up in the team’s assigned area. Teams may begin campsite SET-UP at 6:30 am Saturday April 23, and must REMOVE all tents and campsites by 10 a.m. on Sunday, April 24th.

Note: If your team is using a tent company: Bernie Thomas Logistics Chair, MUST be made aware of ANY tent companies planning to set up on Friday. Please email marah.johnson@cancer.org or call 706-731-0152 Teams will be responsible for moving tents off the field if their tent company cannot finish by 10:00 a.m. on Sunday.

Vehicles ARE NOT ALLOWED on the track or field.

Golf Cars will be provided to assist with loading and unloading before the event begins and once the event is over. Golf Cars will not be provided during the event itself and will only be used for emergency purposes and collecting trash.

Care should be taken in setting up campsites to avoid damaging sprinkler heads.

Small gas grills are permitted on the field, but SAFE Operation is critical. Charcoal fires on the infield are prohibited. Extra-large grills must be placed outside of the field.

Pets are not permitted on the field.

Children must be under the supervision of adults at all times. Youth teams must have a chaperone. Youth Waivers are online at www.relayforlife.org/augustaga

Tobacco products and alcoholic beverages are NOT allowed.

Teams are responsible for removing their trash. (Wood and metal decorations cannot be put in dumpsters and should not be left behind.)

Because of the high visibility and public location, safety and security should be emphasized to all team members throughout the event. Sheriff Deputies will be onsite. Please do not leave valuables in your car since it is difficult to monitor all cars at all times.

Small and quiet generators allowed(should not go over 70 decibels). We ask that during the Luminaria Ceremony, they are turned off.
