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FAQs After Relay

What is the overall fundraising total for Relay?

All of you contributed to raising just over \$80,000 so far for the 2009 Relay For Life of Dunn County—THANK YOU!! As donations are still coming in, updated totals will be announced online and in the next newsletter.

How much did our team raise? Did we reach National Relay Team Fundraising Club status?

See Page 2 for a list of each team's fundraising total and Fundraising Club status as of June 30. This list is posted online and will be updated periodically. It will also be sent to team captains again at the end of the summer.

How do participants receive individual incentive prizes?

Each individual that raised \$250+ will be mailed an incentive prize certificate during the week of July 13. The certificate contains a validation code, deadline and instructions for claiming your prize.

- Online Team Challenge (first three teams to raise \$1,500+ ONLINE): Deadline—July 24, 2009
- Team Fundraising Club: Deadline for donation submission—August 21, 2009

A limited number of scholarships are awarded each year to young cancer survivors to help with their higher education costs. In addition to meeting general eligibility requirements (diagnosed with cancer before age 21, under the age of 25, legal resident of a Midwest Division state, etc.), candidates are selected on the basis of their commitment to academic or vocational goals, current financial need, leadership, and community service. Message of the Month: Sun Safety

Skin cancer is the most common of all cancers. More than one million cases of skin cancer are found in the USA alone each year. Reduce your skin cancer risk with good sun habits.

- Use sunscreen with SPF 15 or higher. Apply a generous amount (about a palm full) and reapply after swimming, toweling dry, or perspiring, or after two hours have passed.
- Wear sunglasses that block ultraviolet (UV) rays. Look for glasses that offer 99-100% protection.
- Limit direct sun exposure between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. Keep your skin covered.
- Avoid tanning beds and sunlamps. The UV rays of tanning beds ARE harmful.
- **Protect yourself year-round.** UV rays cause damage throughout the year, not just in the summer.

SLIP on a shirt. SLAP on a hat. SLOP on some sunscreen. SLIDE on sunglasses.


