



Relay For Life of Greater Morristown-- Frequently Asked Questions

When does the event start? Registration will open at 2pm and Opening Ceremonies will commence promptly at 4:00 PM

When does the event end? Closing Ceremonies will be at 10:40 PM with closing lap at 10:55 PM

What happens if there is bad weather? This event is rain or shine. If we need to move it indoors we have that option.

What should I pack? Just in case, warm apparel if it gets cool at night and if you want to see the ice show inside. Bring a tent (table/chairs) sunscreen, hat, sunglasses and snacks but there is a snack bar that will be open inside Mennen.

Can I bring a dog? We love dogs, but Relay For Life is for our two-legged friends and family only. No pets please. Think about attending one of the American Cancer Society's Bark For Life events!

Will there be food? Mennen does have a concession stand inside. The survivor/caregiver dinner (free of charge) will be served at 6:00 pm for the survivor and their caregiver.

Will there be bathrooms? Yes, bathrooms will be available inside Mennen arena

Will there be water? Bottled water will be available free of charge to all participants. ShopRite is handing out water at their Tent.

Where should I park? There is a lot of parking right by the Rugby field but if (hopefully) we have so many people that it gets full, you can park behind the building.

What time should I show up? Feel free to arrive at 2:00 PM to set up your tents. The camp sites are on a first come first serve basis. Registration begins at 3:00 PM with opening ceremonies promptly at 4:00 PM.

If there is a problem or emergency, what should I do? Locate a Leadership Committee member that is wearing a Blue shirt and alert them of the problem so they can seek help.

Can we have alcohol at the event? Alcohol and tobacco products are strictly prohibited at a Relay For Life event.

Do I have to walk the whole time? No, We ask that, to represent the mantra that “cancer never sleeps”, each team has a representative walking the track at all times (if possible). This does not have to be one person.

Can I decorate my camp site? ABSOLUTELY!!! Get creative!

Should I bring a Team Banner? Yes, be creative! Everyone will be walking after Survivor/Caregiver lap so be proud of your team and show it off!!

I'm a Survivor, do I have to pay? There is no fee for Survivors to participate!

I am attending the Survivor Reception. What can I expect? The Survivor Reception will begin approximately 6:00 PM in the Survivor Tent. Applebee's will be catering the dinner.

Can I buy Luminaria bags and or Memorial Garden Flowers at the event? Luminaria bags will be on sale for \$10 each and the flowers \$2.00 each at the event up until approximately 8:00 PM.

Can I hand money in at the event? Yes. We will be collecting donations at the Registration Table and any money from fundraising you do on site.

Is it too late to start/continue fundraising? Its never too late to fundraise! You can even fundraise at your camp site at the event!

Does the website shut down prior to the event? The website will shut down for only registration Thursday evening the 15th. By all means, you can continue to enter donations!

Should I bring items for the theme laps? Yes, be creative. Check the schedule for each lap and dress appropriately for each.

Should I forward this email with attachments to my team? Yes, we want to make sure everyone knows what to expect!

What do we do with our trash? There will be garbage cans set up through out the venue.
