# Your Relay dollars at work...

## RESEARCH, PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

### RESEARCH

- The American Cancer Society funds researchers early in their careers – 42 of whom have gone on to win the Nobel Prize.
- The American Cancer Society funded more than \$130 million in cancer research this year, more than \$2.4 billion since 1946.
- The American Cancer Society tracks lifestyle and behaviors of 1.2 million volunteers to study risk factors associated with cancer.
- The American Cancer Society established the link between cancer and smoking.
- The American Cancer Society focuses part of its funds on specific needs, such as cancer in the poor and underserved.
- Dramatically increased the cure rate for most childhood leukemias to more than 80%
- ACS researchers developed the pap smear, the psa test, bone marrow transplants, CT scan, MRI, mammography.

### INFORMATION

**1.800.ACS.2345**, accessible 24 hours-a-day, 7 days per week, connects a caller directly to a trained Cancer Information Specialist, who may be an oncology nurse or social worker, or the caller may be referred to local programs. The ACS **Patient Navigation Center** (1.800.ACS.2345) assists the cancer patient from diagnosis through treatment and long-term survival by identifying and accessing resources and support for the patient and their family.

**Our website, [www.cancer.org](http://www.cancer.org)**, offers statistics, information on all cancers and available resources, clinical trials matching, and access to the Cancer Survivors Network, as well as information about American Cancer Society programs and services.

### QUALITY OF LIFE

**Cancer Survivors Network** is a telephone-based (1.877.333.4673) and web-based ([www.cancer.org](http://www.cancer.org)) support service created by and for cancer survivors, their families, caregivers, and friends. It is designed to address their need to connect with others.

**Hope Lodge** is a home away from home for cancer patients and their caregivers. It provides free lodging and a supportive environment while cancer patients are undergoing outpatient treatment.

## **Your Donations Support Programs, Services in Georgia**

Following is a listing of some of the ACS programs available in North Carolina. For more information, call **1-800-ACS-2345**.

**Tell-A-Friend** – Trained volunteers encourage their friends to get mammograms to screen for breast cancer.

**Reach to Recovery** – A one-to-one peer support program of breast cancer survivors. These volunteers are trained to respond to individuals with a concern about breast cancer, those facing a possible diagnosis of breast cancer, as well as people recently diagnosed who are going through breast cancer diagnosis or treatment.

**Look Good...Feel Better** – This program teaches female cancer patients beauty techniques to enhance their self-image during cancer treatments. A program is currently offered at Greene General Hospital!

**I Can Cope** – A series of educational classes for cancer patients, their families and friends. Doctors, nurses, social workers and other health care professionals provide information about cancer, encouragement and practical hints through presentations and class discussions.

**Man to Man** – A support program in which prostate cancer survivors provide one-on-one support to prostate cancer patients. Patients also can turn to the ACS's Expert Answers bulletin board to ask questions that are answered by medical experts.

**Road to Recovery** – Trained volunteer drivers provide cancer patients with rides to and from treatment. Please sign up for a training today!

**Freshstart** – Trained volunteers help others quit smoking.

**Clean Indoor Air Coalitions** – Advocates work with community groups to pass local policies that reduce tobacco use.

**Tobacco Use Prevention Youth Teams** – This program helps youth groups organize and implement effective community advocacy projects.

**Community Development Grants** – A grant program designed to financially support community projects that are consistent with cancer control objectives. Grants ranging from \$1,000 to \$10,000 are awarded after review and approval by a team that includes ACS volunteers and staff. Greene County was chosen to receive one of these grants this year for minority breast cancer patients!

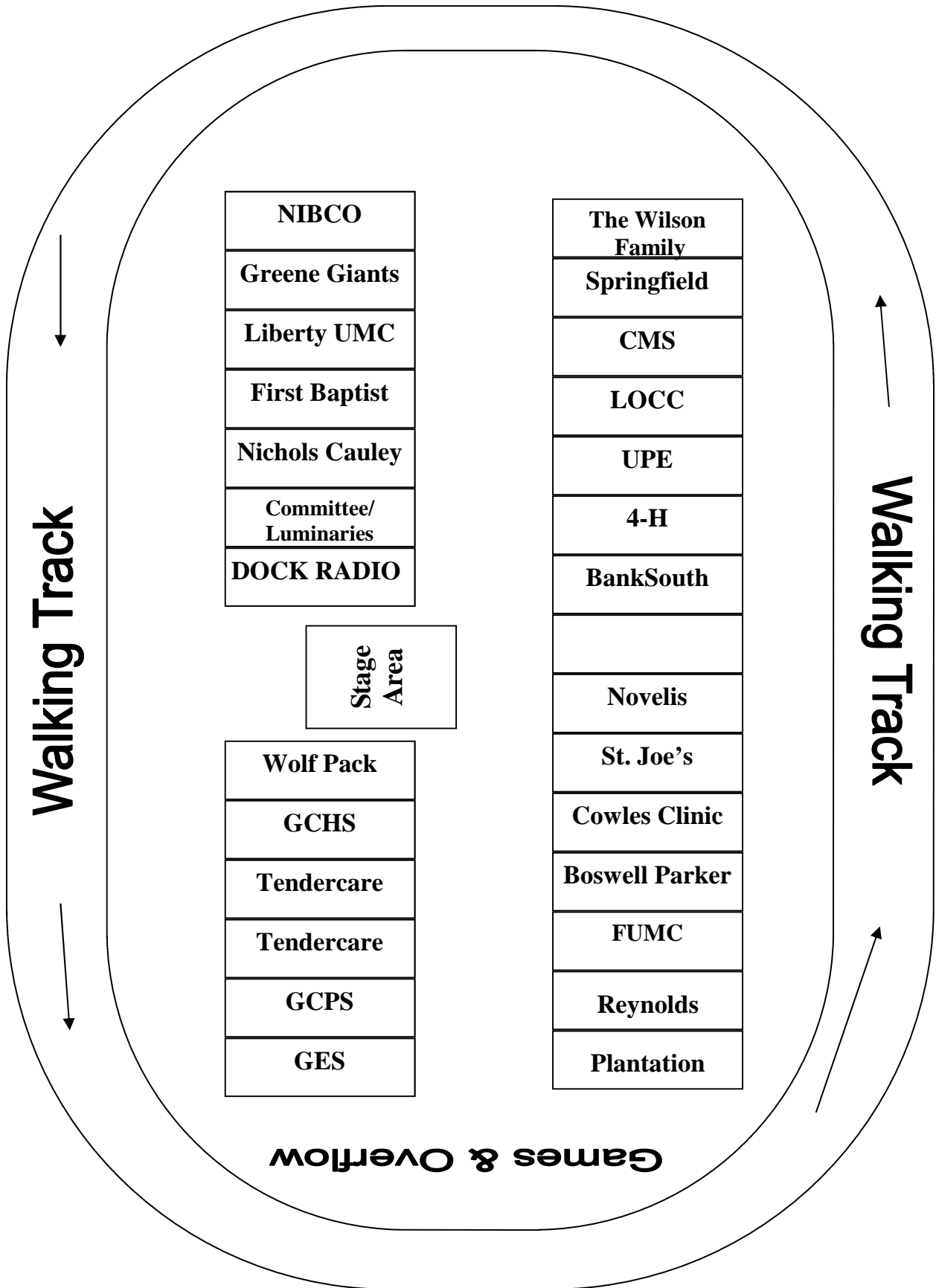
