Relay Bucks

What are Relay Bucks? Relay Bucks are awarded to recognize Relay For Life teams who show Spirit throughout the Relay For Life Season and at the event.

How do we earn Relay Bucks? Teams and Team Members can earn Relay Bucks by participating in a variety of events and activities leading up to and during Relay For Life.

Why do we want Relay Bucks? The team that earns the most Relay Bucks will take home the coveted Team Spirit Award at Relay!!!

Best Team Banner Award

After the opening lap, banners will need to be displayed by each team at their campsite. It is up to the team to decide how to best display their banner.

Survivors who attend the dinner will be given ballots to vote on the Best Banner. Whichever team banner receives the most votes wins! We will have 1st, 2nd and 3rd Place awards.

Best Campsite Award

Each team will create a board game themed campsite area.

Survivors who attend the dinner will be given ballots to vote on the Best Banner. Whichever team campsite receives the most votes wins! We will have 1st, 2nd and 3rd Place awards.

How to earn bucks:

Hope Club:

Reach Hope Club Level (raise \$100) by May 9th: 100 bucks/team member

Team or ELT Recruitment:

Recruit someone to join the committee: 500 bucks/new member

Recruit a new team: 150 bucks/new team

10 or more team members online by May 1st: 300 bucks

ACS CAN:

Become an ACS CAN member: 50 bucks for Team Captain, 25 bucks/participant

Become an ACS CAN Club Team: 500 bucks

Sponsorship Recruitment: (see sponsorship packet)

Recruit a Signature Sponsor: 50 bucks/Sponsor

Recruit a Bronze Sponsor: 100 bucks/Sponsor

Recruit a Silver Sponsor: 250 bucks/Sponsor

Recruit a Platinum Sponsor: 750 bucks/Sponsor

Register online: 25 bucks for your team, and 1 buck/team member

Attend a team meeting: 25 bucks/meeting /team

Day of Relay:

Volunteer to help run an activity day of event: 100 bucks

Volunteer at Registration: 150 bucks

Survivor registered on your team: 200 bucks each

Reach a Team Fundraising Club Level (team raises \$1,000+): 150 bucks

Reach the Grand Club: (raise \$1,000) 250 bucks/team member

Reach All Star (raise \$2,500): 500 bucks per/team member

Team member(s) participate in an activity: 50 bucks per activity

Team member (s) participate in theme lap: 50 bucks per theme lap

Decorated campsite: 100 bucks

Decorated team banner: 100 bucks

1st Place in an activity: 300 bucks

2nd Place in an activity: 200 bucks

3rd Place in an activity: 100 bucks

Each team member walking the track at 3am: 25 bucks/person

Each team member walking the track at 5am: 50 bucks/person

Each team member at Closing Ceremony: 100 bucks per person (this could be the deciding factor for the Team Spirit Award!!!)

Additional Relay Bucks can be earned for “Embodying the Spirit of Relay” at the discretion of the committee members.
