One of the highlights at the American Cancer Society's Relay For Life is the Luminaria Ceremony. This event takes place at dusk during Relay For Life. It is an opportunity to help in the fight against cancer; and pay tribute to someone in your life who has been touched by cancer. You will be truly lighting the way for cancer research, education programs and patient services.

What is a Luminaria? A Luminaria consists of a small white bag filled with sand and a small light source. The outside of the bag is personalized to recognize people who have battled cancer. You can salute a cancer survivor "in honor of" or remember someone who has lost the battle "in memory of". The candles are lit during a special ceremony, and they burn all night... lighting the way for the walkers.

We suggest a \$10 donation per bag, but you can make a donation of any amount and have a Luminaria lit at Relay For Life. Proceeds will benefit the cancer-fighting work of the American Cancer Society.
