



Why We Relay

Survivor Lap: Begins at Friday evening at 6:00 pm at the boat ramp entrance to the pathway. Survivor reception will follow at the Survivor tent located next to the Entertainment tent..

Opening Ceremony: Immediately following the Survivor Lap under the Entertainment Tent.

Caregiver Lap: Following the Opening Ceremony (around 7:00 pm) leaving from the Entertainment Tent

Luminaria Ceremony: Friday evening at 9:00 pm under the Entertainment tent to be followed by a candlelit Remembrance Lap.

Fight Back Ceremony: Saturday at noon under the Entertainment tent.

Closing Ceremony: Saturday at 4:00 pm under the Entertainment tent.

Important Locations to Know

Registration Tent—The large tent facing the North Parking Lot.

Entertainment Tent—on the lakeside of the pathway opposite the Registration tent

Survivor Tent—Between the Basket & Entertainment tents.

Basket Tent—the farthest tent to the left of the Entertainment Tent.

Children's Activities Tent—on Saturday the Survivor tent will be used for Children's' Activities.

Lost & Found— will be located at the Entertainment tent.

Restroom Facilities— located at the Beach House and at the Conroy Pavilion. There are also port-o-lets in the North Parking Lot, and at the boat ramp parking lot turn around. Please have respect to your fellow relayers and keep them clean.

Parking at the North Parking Lot on Friday evening is for Survivors Only there is parking at Taconic High School with shuttle service to and from the park on Friday.

The last shuttle out of the park on Friday will be at 11:00 pm. For those participants staying over you can move your car to the main parking area after 10:00 pm on Friday. If you need transportation out of the park afterwards please see a Relay Security member. There will be no shuttle service on Saturday.

No outside fires except for in enclosed fire places or hibachi grills.
