

Silent Auction Rules

Windham Relay for Life

Hours of Operation: Saturday 11:30 am to 8:00 pm
Sunday 8:30 am to 10:00 am

1. All auction items are sold "as is" with no warranties or guarantees expressed or implied. The American Cancer Society is not liable for any consequences of participation in and/or use of auction items, not excluding limitations and specifications outlined as part of the auction item(s).
2. Winning bidders shall claim and pay in full at the close of the Silent Auction on Sunday, at the auction registration table. Payment shall be accepted by cash, check or charge (Master Card & Visa only.) Cash is preferred for processing purposes. No promises, no notes, no IOU's, no bounced checks. If you can't afford to pay, don't bid. A bid is a legal contract. Winning bidders must show identification at time of payment. Checks are to be made payable to the American Cancer Society.
3. No item will be released without payment.
4. Item will be released to next highest bidder if payment is not made immediately at close of the auction on Sunday.
5. All items must be picked up and payment made at close of Relay, 11:00 am on Sunday.
6. You must be 21 or older to bid.
7. Bidding will be executed by placing your name and bid on the bid sheets. You must open with the minimum bid indicated on the bid sheet. Raises must be made in increments of \$5.00.
8. In the event of dispute, the auction chair, (at her/his discretion), reserves the right to determine the successful bidder. The auctioneer has the final say.
9. We are advised that your bids may be tax deductible, but you should check with your accountant or the IRS for advice.
10. Execution of all rules is at the discretion of the American Cancer Society.
11. No one will be allowed to squeak-in with bids after auctioneer announces the closing of the bidding. All bids must be completely placed before closing of the auction bidding.
