- The American Cancer Society's sister organization, the Cancer Action Network (ACS CAN), continues to support laws and policies that keep cancer a national priority. - The American Cancer Society's state of the art, NYC Hope Lodge facility is designed to offer cancer patients and their families a free, temporary place to stay while receiving treatment away from home. Since opening in November 2007 over 7,000 patients and caregivers have been able to stay at Hope Lodge.
- In 2011, 147 children enjoyed the opportunity to attend the American Cancer Society's Camp Adventure program, a free week long, medically supervised camp on Shelter Island for kids with cancer and their siblings.
- The Suffolk Office of your American Cancer Society houses a Patient Care Program where 118 women have comfortably and privately receive free wigs and head coverings.
- We offer Look Good...Feel Better sessions at 12 different treatment center locations in Suffolk County to address the cosmetic effects of treatment. Each participant receives a free make-up and skin care kit and the reassurance of knowing they are not alone.
- Your American Cancer Society is happy to provide a free Personal Health Manager tool kit to every newly diagnosed individual, which helps in organizing treatment-related information and keeping the patients' entire health care team informed of their progress.
