The group is open to men and women who are currently being treated for cancer, or who have gone through it in the past. People who are in remission still often have issues to deal with and also can be a great inspiration to those who are currently struggling with treatment.

The group meets in the Atrium, on the first floor next to the Fellowship Hall.
