### ***Relay for Life of Harrison Township***

#### ***YOUTH RULES AND REGULATIONS:***

1. There are no longer any athletics allowed on the field during the entire Relay for Life event May 3, 2014 – May 4, 2014. This includes: balls, discs, equipment, flying objects of any kind, or ANYTHING related to athletics.
2. ALL youth participants/team captains will be REQUIRED to wear wristbands (which will be distributed the morning of May 3, 2014). There will be one wristband indicating that you are a REGISTERED participant and one wristband indicating that you have raised the required amount of monies to stay overnight.
3. Student I.D. will be REQUIRED in order to obtain wristbands.
4. If you are a visitor to the event or have visitors attending the event, ALL persons under the age of 18 will be removed from the event at 11:00 p.m. unless you have both wristbands. We will be checking ALL AREAS including but not limited to tents, bathrooms, and any areas used for hiding.
5. Any youth wishing to stay overnight needs to raise \$100.00 in order to obtain the overnight wristband. These monies MUST BE RAISED by check-in time on Saturday, May 3, 2014. If you do not have your monies turned in at this time, you will not receive a wristband and therefore cannot stay overnight. NO EXCEPTIONS!!
6. There will be a security presence for the full 24 hour event. If you are a registered participant and have been removed from the event for breaking any rules and regulations, your parents will be called and you will not be allowed re-entry to the event.
7. An email will be sent to ALL LCHS parents about the event, the rules and regulations of the event, youth participation, and it will list youth expectations.
8. ALL teams MUST have one (1) chaperone per ten (10) team members under the age of 18. Each chaperone must be over the age of 21 and will be responsible for each of the ten (10) team members they are supervising.



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9. Youth participants/Team Captains **MUST** have the required parental permission slips turned in by check-in time on Saturday, May 3, 2014. If we do not have a signed permission slip for each team member under the age of 18, wristbands will not be distributed to that particular team member.
  
10. Relay for Life of Harrison Township encourages you to come out to the event and participate on a team! We want you to have fun and engage in Relay in a positive and respectful manner. These new rules and regulations were set in place to protect all parties involved and are supported by your Principal, Mr. Czapski and your Associate Principal, Ms. Williams.
