- Family & friends
- Donations (bring to Accounting tent)
- Decorated Luminaria (can be dropped at Luminaria Table)
- Unused supplies (bring to the Registration tent)
- Tent w/rain fly (Just in case!) or screen house
- Hammer for setting the tent stakes
- Table for food, games, etc
- Sleeping bag/pillow
- Chairs
- Dress in layers – don't forget extra socks
- Sneakers
- Items to donate to the Silent Auction
- Supplies for any on-site fundraisers
- Signs thanking any corporate businesses or sponsors of your team
- Flashlight & lanterns (battery operated) and extra batteries
- Paper towels, wet wipes, trash bags
- Long handled lighters for lighting luminaria
- Cash – There will be fundraising games, food, and products sold at the event
- Cooler with ice and drinks (no alcohol permitted on school grounds)
- Sunscreen
- Personal medication and care items
- Umbrella
- Camera
- Insect Repellent
- Cell phone - charged
- Snacks
- Frisbee, Nerf football, etc.
- Group activity games and decks of cards
- Decorations for your campsite
- Team costumes
- A wagon to transport all this from car to campsite
