#### Starting a team:

First and foremost, please fill out and turn in the green team captain info sheet enclosed to the event chair, staff partner or team development chair so we can stay in touch with you about upcoming meetings and fundraisers.

#### <u>Important Meetings:</u>

#### Committee:


## Sign Up. Set Up. Start Fundraising.

Follow the step-by-step directions below to set up your Relay For Life webpage and get going.


#### **Step 1: Find Your Event.**

Go to: relayforlife.org to locate your event, then click 'Sign Up'.




#### **Step 2: Register for an Event.**

If you have participated in a previous event, login as a "Returning Participant" to reform your team, or start a new one. If you are a new participant, make a selection on the right to begin the registration process.




Returning Participants have access to their personal page and address book from the previous year. If you have forgotten your password, you can request it by email using the "Forgot username or password?" link.




Reforming a team will also give you access to your team page from the previous year.

New Participants may choose to start a team, join an existing team, register for the Survivor Lap, or walk as individuals.




#### **Step 3: Continue registration.**

Complete the registration process by following the instructions on each page.




#### Step 5: Personalize your Web page.

Photo (must be .jpg and smaller than 200 kb), or add a YouTube video.


• Click on 'Edit My URL' to create a short URL for your personal page.

#### Step 7: Send emails to friends and family.


Click 'Compose an Email' in your Dashboard.

## Free Programs and Patient Support

#### Toll-Free Number and Website

The American Cancer Society operates a toll-free number 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Cancer Information Specialists answer questions about a patient's diagnosis/treatment and direct patients to resources within the American Cancer Society.

Call 1-800-227-2345 or check out our website at www.cancer.org.

#### Patient Navigation

"Patient Navigators" provide information about cancer and treatment options. They answer your questions and suggest questions to ask the doctor. Navigators can also help with questions regarding financial and insurance needs, and locate resources for assistance. Additionally, they provide emotional support and information to your loved ones. Call **1-800-227-2345**.

#### Personal Health Manager (PHM)

PHM is a free cancer information tool-kit made specifically to assist cancer patients within the first 12 months of their diagnosis. Pick one up at an American Cancer Society office or call your local office for more information about how to receive one.

#### Road to Recovery

RTR is a volunteer driver program dedicated to providing cancer patients with free transportation to and from medically necessary appointments related to a cancer diagnosis. Oklahoma communities that currently have a Road to Recovery Program include Ada, Ardmore, Bartlesville, Enid, Idabel, Muskogee, McAlester, Oklahoma City, Shawnee, Norman, Stillwater, and Tulsa. Patients must be able to walk independently to get in and out of the vehicle and treatment facility. For more information call the office nearest you.

#### Wig Room

The American Cancer Society provides wigs free of charge to cancer patients in active treatment. Turbans, hats and other head coverings are also available. Patients can visit their closest American Cancer Society Resource Room or Office during normal business hours. Call **1-800-227-2345** or your local office for more information.

#### Guest Room Program

Guest Room is a program designed to provide free or low-cost accommodations for patients undergoing treatment on an outpatient basis at a facility at least 50 miles from their residence. Limited hotels currently participate in the program by donating rooms as availability permits. The Guest Room Program will be utilized only by those patients having a financial need and who would otherwise be unable to receive treatment without this assistance. Contact the American Cancer Society at **1-800-227-2345** for more information and availability.

#### Look Good...Feel Better (LGFB)

LGFB is a program designed to help women deal with the appearance-related side effects of cancer treatment. Licensed cosmetologists volunteer their time to teach patients makeup techniques that can help a woman regain her sense of self confidence and ultimately help her look good and feel better! Also included is information about wigs, turbans and head wraps. Patients who attend a group session receive a free makeup kit. Call **1-800-227-2345** for session locations and times.

A "Look Good...Feel Better" self-help kit is available for patients who live in areas where no group session is available or who are ill or unable to find transportation to a group session. To receive the self-help kits, call the Look Good...Feel Better toll-free number at 1-800-395-LOOK. A 30 minute video and patient instruction booklet is included with the self-help kit. (The makeup kit is not included.)

#### Breast Prostheses & Mastectomy Bras

The American Cancer Society has both prostheses and mastectomy bras available free of charge to cancer patients. Contact the American Cancer Society office closest to you for additional information or to find a location for free fittings.

#### Reach to Recovery

Reach to Recovery is a visitation program utilizing volunteer breast cancer survivors who respond to concerns of breast cancer patients and their families facing diagnosis, treatment, and effects of breast cancer. A Reach to Recovery Volunteer provides a "listening ear," recommends resources and offers emotional support. Contact the American Cancer Society at **1-800-227-2345** for more information or to request a visit.

#### Cancer Survivor's Network

The Cancer Survivor's Network is an internet-based source of information and support for cancer patients and family members. Survivors and their families, friends and caregivers share experiences of living with cancer and caring for those they love. #### • Support Groups
