QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

Q: What is the Relay For Life?

A: The Relay For Life is a community fundraising walk sponsored by the American Cancer Society that will take place at the WHS track from noon to midnight on June 13, 2015. Participants raise funds, participate in the ceremonies and walk the track throughout the day to fight against cancer!

Q: What do I need to do to get started?

A: Students must pre-register in the Library or VIP Center **before June 1**^{st.}

Q: What will be expected of me?

A: Three things are required:

- 1. You will be required to register as a participant on a Relay team at: www.relayforlife.org/weymouthma.
- 2. You will be required to raise a minimum of \$100.00 by JUNE 1, 2015 in funds that go directly to the American Cancer Society to support cancer research and programs.
- 3. You will be required to actively participate in the Relay on June 13th.

Q: How many Community Service Hours will I earn?:

A: If you have met all the requirements above and are present and participating for the duration of the Relay, you will receive up to 10 hours of community service. If you satisfy the above requirements and participate for partial duration of the Relay, you will receive credit for the number of hours you have participated.

Q: How will my hours be submitted to WHS?

A: The Chairperson for the Relay for Life Planning Committee will complete the required form for you and submit it directly to WHS.

Q: What if I cannot participate for the entire event?

A: As long as you have completed the registration and fundraising requirements, you can participate for whatever hours possible, but you will only receive community service credit for the hours you are participating.

Q: How can I start my own Team?

A: You can start a new Team during the registration process on the RFL website. However, you must follow rules that for every 10 participants under the age of 18, there must be at least one adult, 25 years or older, present during the Relay.

Q: What if I miss the June 1st deadline for Pre-registration?

A: You will not be eligible to receive community service hours!!!!!

Q: What are the dates and times for this year's Relay?

A: The Relay will run at WHS from 12:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 13th through 12:00 a.m.

Q: Can I involve my family in this event?

A: Absolutely! Relay is a family event and we encourage participation with your family members.
